This Indenture makes and contains with this 20th day of June in the year 1833, between George Clare and Rebecca his wife of the one part and David Black of the other part; witnesseth that the said George Clare and Rebecca his wife in consideration of the sum of \$120. of lawful money of the commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said David Black the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do give grant bargain and sell and confirm unto the said David Black his heirs and assigns, his lots or parcels of land one front and one back, situated lying and being in the town of Lebanon in the county of Hampshire in the state of New Hampshire by the numbers 15 and 32. To have and to hold the said lot or parcel of land together with all and singular the appurtenances unto him the said David Black his heirs and assigns forever and the said George Clare and Rebecca as his wife for themselves and their heirs the said lot or parcel of land with their appurtenances to the said David Black and his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said George Clare and Rebecca his wife or either of them, and their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall well and lawfully and forever defend by their persons in victory whereof the said George Clare and Rebecca his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
