That in Consideration of the Sum of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) to be paid, as follows: \$2000.00 Cash upon the delivery of possession of the hereinafter described lot of land, and the balance of \$3000.00 to be paid in two equal annual payments for which note, bearing interest from the date of possession which will be on or about the 1st day of September, 1914, are to be executed, the said parties of the first part sell, grant, and convey unto the said party of the second part, with general warranty of title, all those two Certain Lots or parcels of land, lying and being in the Blackfooting Magistral District of Montgomery County, Containing by recent Survey 2.40 Acres, containing two dwelling houses and Lot, Lot No. 1 known as the Emily C. Houston residence Lot and which is owned jointly by her, the price of which in this conveyance is \$2000.00, and Lot No. 2 is known as the Mrs. Helen B. Price House and Lot, and which was conveyed to the grantor by Helen B.
