Palmer for their good cause and considerations moving him the said William F. Palmer in the premises he the said William F. Palmer has given granted, conveyed, sold and conveyed, + by these presents doth give grant bargain + sell and convey with general warranty unto the said Robert L. Goodrich, John D. Goodrich and John G. Goodrich forever, all that certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Montgomery and State of Virginia, and comprised of the two adjacent tracts or parcels of land now of record in some and called by the name of Mountain River and the other by the name of the Jewell Place, the former of which tract or parcel of land has been and called or appraised by the name of Mountain River has adjacent to the town of Blacksburg and upon the north east side of the public road which leads from Blacksburg to Christiansburg and which is known as the Old Peppers Ferry + Salem turnpike road and joins the lands of J. H. Goodrich, J. M. Thomas, W. H. Hall and others, and the latter of which tract or parcel of land has been and called by the name of the Jewell Place joins the said place known as Mountain River + the lands of J. H. Goodrich, J. M.
