

*Present 11/20/1905 to Mary and
Proctor in Lumber survey*

This deed made this 6th day of April 1875, between John Lybrook and Mary his wife in the County of Montgomery, State of Virginia Protestant Ep^o of the first part and Ambrose Robinson, Chas S. C. Minor, Jas. H. Church, Alonzo Kane, Gray Carroll, Wm. B. Wiley, Stetson Keith, B. J. Elliott, A. H. Adams, Chas. A. Colbourn, Alex. P. Kirkridge, and Wm. F. Tallant. Vestry of the Protestant Episcopal Church, Montgomery Parish in the Diocese of Virginia, and their successors of the second part, witnesseth that whereas the said John Lybrook and Mary his wife have heretofore sold and conveyed by deed bearing date of the 29th of Dec 1874 to the said parties of the second part a certain lot situated in the town of Bloomsburg in the County of Montgomery, such lot is fifty feet front and eighty feet deep and its exact location being exactly described in said deed heretofore made. Now therefore in consideration of the additional sum of fifty dollars paid to the said John Lybrook the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said John Lybrook, and Mary his wife have given, granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do give, grant, bargain and sell unto the parties of the second part Vestry as a before said and their successors, ten additional feet of ground so as to make the heretofore purchased lot fifty feet front and ninety feet deep, and the title to which the parties of the first part warrant generally, Witness the following signatures & seals.
