Witnesseth that the said John Walters & Nancy Walters his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars in hand paid by the said George Keister before the signing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell one moiety of a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the said county of Montgomery on the waters of some of the heads of Stroubles creek, a branch of New river, and some of the head waters of Ingles mill creek and containing one hundred and thirty acres (130) in the same more or less, it being the same tract sold to the said John Walters and George Keister by Henry Edmundson as Trustee of John Preston by deed bearing date of the 30th March 1826, and by him the said Henry Edmundson acknowledged as Trustee aforesaid in the Clerk's Office of the county of Montgomery on the 5th day of April 1826, by referring to which a full and perfect description of the tract bounds &c. of the said tract or parcel of land will be seen; To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to him the said George Keister and to his heirs and assigns forever, free from the claim or claims of him the said John Walters and Nancy his wife, and their heirs and from all persons whomsoever claiming under them: In Testimony whereof the said John Walters and Nancy his wife have hereunto placed their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written.
