KNOW all men by these presents, that I Philip Barger sen^r and Barbara Barger both of the County of Montgomery and State of Virginia for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which we bear to John Barger our son of said State and County as well as for the further consideration of One dollar to us in hand paid by the said John Barger at or before the signing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John Barger his Executors administrators and assigns, all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty acres more or less lying and being in the County of Montgomery (formerly Augusta) on Cedar Creek a branch of Roan Oak, which said land was patented in the name of Peter Miller Ape of Wm Davidson who was Assignee of William Henly by patent bearing date the seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty and of the Commonwealth the twelfth, and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a black oak by a blade and running thence south fifty degrees west one hundred poles to a black oak, in the barrens, south forty eight degrees east one hundred and thirty poles to two white oaks, south fifteen degrees East ninety poles to four white oaks by a sink hole, east forty poles to two white oaks by a branch north one hundred & sixty poles, thence along a hill one hundred and ten poles to the Beginning. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land unto him the said John Barger his Executors administrators and assigns forever. and the said Philip Barger and Barbara his wife for themselves their Executors & administrators the said tract of land unto the said John Barger his Executors administrators and assigns against them the said Barger

The Indenture made the second day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and three between Zachariah Stanley of the County of Montgomery and State of Virginia of the one part and Jacob Borg of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Zachariah Stanley for and in consideration of the sum of thirty four pounds ten shillings to him in hand paid the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold alien released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien release and confirm unto the said Jacob Borg his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid including the head of Frederick Smyth's Run a branch of the North fork of Roanoke containing by estimation one hundred and fifteen Acres be the same more or less being granted by patent bearing date the fourteenth of April one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight to the aforesaid Zachariah Stanley and bounded as followeth to wit Beginning at a decut and black oak by a sink hole north forty seven degrees west fifty four poles to two white oaks south fifty eight degrees west one hundred and sixty two poles crossing three branches to a black Oak & white oak north eighty six degrees west twenty two poles to a double chestnut south fifty eight degrees west forty four poles to a large white oak and black oak south four degrees west fifty poles to two white oaks and a black oak south fifty five degrees west fifty six poles to three black oaks north sixty degrees east one hundred and forty six poles to a lynn tree north thirteen degrees east one hundred and twenty two poles to the Beginning with all the woods under woods orchards waters and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the renovations and remainder and remaining rents and offices of the premises or any part whereof and also all right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of said Zachariah Stanley in and to the premises to have
