 to V hundred & nine between John Barger & Jane his wife of the one part of the county of Mont
 Hancock gannay and George Hancock of Antelope County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said
 Oliver & John Barger & Jane his wife in order to secure the payment of the following debt viz on
 to said John Barger by bond unto John Preston the first day of January 1811 for the sum of eight
 hundred & dollars & one half of eighty dollars due on or before the first day of May next
 to the said John Preston and in consideration of the further sum of one dollar
 dollar to them in hand paid by the said George Hancock at or before the
