This deed was made the twenty forth day of March in the second year of the said year between Gasper Burger and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and John Robertson of the other part both of the County of Montgomery and State of Virginia Witnesses that this said Gasper Burger and Elizabeth his wife in consideration of one dollar to them in hand paid on or before the making and delivery of these presents (the said whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do sell bargain and sell unto the said John Robertson his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Montgomery on Thom's Creek the waters of said River containing two hundred and thirty acres and eight poles be the same more or less as laid off by Gordon Lloyd the 14th of April 1809 and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at three white oaks on the north side of the creek by a fence North twenty one and an half degrees East thirty three poles to a white oak by a line and on half degree west thirty poles to a white oak by a line North forty six degrees from pole to pole white oak on a Ridge South sixty five and fifty poles to a double white oak by a fence four poles from a bunch of Oaks at the creek South thirty seven degrees east two hundred and eighty five poles crossing the creek to a white oak by a line North by degree one hundred and eighty seven poles to a white oak by a line North thirty seven and on half degree crossing the creek to the Beginning together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging and every good and lawful thing to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the hundred and thirty acres and all and singular other the premises thereto belonging or intended to be bargained and sold and every good and lawful thing thereof unto the said John Abraham his heirs and assigns forever and the said Gasper Burger and Elizabeth his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John Robertson his heirs and assigns

Bowles, Esq This Indenture made this second day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & nine between Joseph King acting Executor of the last will and Testament of William Bowles Sr of the one part and Peter Hornbarger of the County of Montgomery Virginia of the other part Witnesseth That whereas the said William Bowles by his last will & Testament directed all his real Estate to be sold for the purposes expressed & and was therein mentioned pursuant to which the said Joseph King as Executor of the said Estate for in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred & one Dollar in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged with burgained & sold unto the said Peter Hornbarger the three following Tracts or parcels of Lands with all the appurtenances thereto belonging viz one Tract or parcel of Lands containing one hundred & forty eight acres more or less lying being in the County of Montgomery adjacent on both sides of Crab Creek a branch of new River adjoining the lands of John Taylor at the lower end of the tract and at the upper end the land belonging to Elizabeth Taylor and bounded as follows Beginning at three white oaks in the patent line and corner to Taylor's land thence with the patent line north twenty three degrees west 122 poles to three pines south twenty six degrees west 10 poles to two small pines by a Gully thence having the patent line as a course the survey south twenty degrees East sixty two poles to a white oak by a meadow south eleven degrees East 227 poles to two Spanish Oaks on a ridge in a line of the patent land & with the same south sixty three degrees East 11 poles to a line thence crossing the survey corner to said Taylor's land & with the same north ten degrees East 214 poles to the Beginning the other tract adjoining the aforesaid land & bounded as follows Beginning at a white oak corner to the above mentioned tract of Taylor's land thence East one hundred & four poles to a white
